Review the Alphabet, and the pronunciation of diphthongs

Vocabulary

άρχη - beginning θεος - God λογος - word οὐρανος - heaven πατηρ - father

έν - in ην - he/she/it was ημων - of us, our και - and, also ο - the προς - towards, with τον - the (Accusative - object of the verb) τοις - the (Dative plural)

Another Phrase:

πατερ ήμων ὁ ἐν τοις οὐρανοις

Father of us, the one in the heavens

Notice how the spelling of some of the words changes slightly from the vocabulary forms - this is called "inflection". We will learn more about inflection in later chapters
