Review the Alphabet, and the pronunciation of diphthongs

Vocabulary

ἀρχη - beginning

θεος - God

λογος - word

οὐρανός - heaven

πατήρ - father

ἐν - in

ἦν - he/she/it was

ἡμῶν - of us, our

καί - and, also

ὁ - the

πρός - towards, with

τον - the (Accusative - object of the verb)

τοις - the (Dative plural)

Another Phrase :

πατερ ἡμῶν ὁ ἐν τοις οὐρανοῖς

Father of us, the one in the heavens

Notice how the spelling of some of the words changes slightly from the vocabulary forms - this is called "inflection". We will learn more about inflection in later chapters
