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**Grammar - the Subjunctive Mood** is used for statements which have some **doubt** about them. The present Subjunctive is formed by broadening the personal endings of the Indicative.

λεγω I may say

λεγῆς you may say

λεγῆι he may say

λεγωμεν we may say

λεγητε you may say

λεγωσιν they may say

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The verb ἀγαπαω - I love

Because the stem ends in α the personal endings "contract" together with the vowel α

ἀγαπῶ I love

ἀγαπᾶς you love

ἀγαπᾷ he loves

ἀγαπῶμεν we love

ἀγαπᾶτε you love
