Second Declension Nouns

The Second Declension contains

Masculine nouns, ending in $-o_S$, Neuter Nouns, ending in $-o_V$, the Name of Jesus, $\ln \sigma o_S$,

and a few Feminine nouns:

ἡ ἐρημος desert
ἡ ὁδος way, road
ἡ παρθενος virgin

Plural

Nom. οι λογοι	τα εργα

- 1. All Nouns ending in -ov are Neuter.
- 2. Neuter Plural Subjects usually take a singular verb they behave as if they were singular collective nouns.
