The Future Indicative Active - part 2

1. Stems ending in Gutturals (κ, γ, χ), Labials (π, β, φ), Dentals (τ, δ, θ) :

κ, γ, χ with σ give ξ ; π, β, φ with σ give ψ ; τ, δ, θ with σ give σ

	Present	Future	Aorist
I lead	ἀγω	ἀξω	ἡγαγον
I open	ἀνοιγω	ἀνοιξω	ἡνοιξα
I baptize	βαπτιζω	βαπτισω	βαπτισα
I write	γραφω	γραψω	γραψα
I teach	διδασκω	διδαξω	διδαξα
I persecute	διωκω	διωξω	διωξα
I have	εχω	εξω	εχον (note change in breathing)
I proclaim	κηρυσσω	κηρυξω	κηρυξα
I cry out	κραζω	κραξω	κραξα
I hide	κρυπτω	κρυψω	κρυψα
I persuade	πειθω	πεισω	πεισα
I do, practice	πρασσω	πραξω	πραξα
I save	σωζω	σωσω	σωσα

2. Liquid Stems (ending in λ, μ, ν or ρ) do not have the sigma. Their Future tenses have the same spelling as the Present, but the accent usually shifts from the stem to the personal ending.

	Present	Future	Aorist
I announce	ἀγγέλλω	ἀγγελω	ἡγγείλα
I lift up	ἀιρω	ἀρω	ἡρα
I kill	ἀποκτείνω	ἀποκτενω	ἀπεκτείνα
I send	ἀποστέλλω	ἀποστελω	ἀπεστείλα
I throw	βάλλω	βαλω	εβαλον
I raise	εγείρω	εγερω	ἡγείρα
I judge	κρίνω	κρινω	εκρινα
I remain	μένω	μενω	εμείνα
I sow	σπείρω	σπερω	εσπείρα

3. Shorter Stems are usually the same as, or similar to, the Aorist Stem.

	Present	Future	Aorist
I find	εύρισκω	εύρησω	εύρον

4. Different Stems :

	Present	Future	Aorist
I come / go	ἐρχομαι	ἐλευσομαι	ἡλθον
I eat	εσθιω	φαγομαι	εφαγον
I take / receive	λαμβανω	λημψομαι	ελαβον
I say	λεγω	ερω	ειπον
I see	όραω	όψομαι	ειδον (note change of breathing)
I carry	φερω	σισω	ηνεγκον
