ειμι : I am

Person	Singular		Plural	
1	I am	έιμι	We are	, εσμεν
2	Thou art	ຣ ີເ	You-all are	έστε
3	He, she, it is	έστιν	They are	ຂໍເσເນ

ειμι (I am) is an irregular verb in Greek (as in English). The related -μι verbs are very old verb forms in Greek.

Examples are:

διδωμι	I give
τιθημι	I place
άφιημι	I forgive
ἀπολλυμι	I destroy
ίστημι	I cause to stand

The $-\mu \iota$ verbs were in use at the time the New Testament was written, but have disappeared from modern Greek.
