# **Short Vocabulary Adjectives of the First and Second Declensions**

The majority of Adjectives belong to this group.

The Masculine forms are declined like λογος

The Feminine forms are declined like  $\alpha\rho\chi\eta$  for stems ending in a consonant,

or like  $\dot{\eta}\mu\epsilon\rho\alpha$  for stems ending in a vowel or **rho**.

The Neuter forms are declined like **EPYOV** 

Compound Adjectives, including those made with the negative prefix  $\dot{\alpha}$ — do not have separate Feminine endings.
