Short Vocabulary

Contract Verbs : with stems in - αω, - εω, - οω

Verbs whose stem ends in -α -ε -ο are called "Contract Verbs" because the vowel of the stem combines (contracts) with the vowels of the personal endings. See the Grammar Pages for the rules of contraction.

The verbs are grouped in order of the number of times they occur in the New Testament.
