Vocabulary

Verbs in -μι

The -μι verbs differ from the -ω verbs only in the Present, Imperfect, and Second Aorist Active and Middle, sometimes in the Second Perfect.

By the time of the New Testament, -νυμι or -ννυμι verbs were changing to -ω forms.

ἀπολλυμι	I destroy	παρατιθημι	I place beside

ἀφιημι	I let go, forgive	περιζωννυμι	I gird myself
ἀφιστημι	I mislead, fall away	πηγνυμι	I fasten together
δεικνυμι	I show	πιμπλημι	I fill, fulfil
διδωμι	I give	προΐστημι	I manage, care for
είμι	I am	προστιθημι	I add
ἐμπιμπλημι	I fill	ρήγνυμι	I tear, burst
ἐξιστημι	I amaze	σβεννυμι	I extinguish
ἐπιτεθημι	I put upon	στρωννυμι	I spread out
ἐφιστημι	I stand near	στορνυμι	I spread out
ζευγνυμι	I yoke	τιθημι	I put, place
ἴημι	I send	ὑποδεικνυμι	I show, indicate
ἴστημι	I stand	φημι	I say
καθιστημι	I appoint
